Re: COMO Mobile Aid Collective

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement for services between COMO Mobile Aid Collective and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. This agreement with COMO Mobile Aid Collective addresses one of the priority areas, homelessness. Under this agreement, COMO Mobile Aid Collective will implement the Street Outreach Program to create connections with, build rapport with, and reduce harm for homeless individuals. The long-term goal of the program is for homeless individuals to make connections to stable housing and services. The agreement is for \$250,000 and will end on January 31, 2027.

Fiscal Impact
