Executive Summary

An Ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the High Impact HIV Prevention and Surveillance Programs for Health Departments Amendment 02 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Human Services for the period of June 1st, 2026 through May 31, 2027 with an amount not to exceed \$285,912 for the period for June 1, 2026 to May 31, 2027.

Discussion

The High Impact HIV Prevention and Surveillance program supports the development and implementation of programs tailored to preventing human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), ending the HIV epidemic and expanding rapid HIV testing in Missouri. The funding supports the provision of comprehensive HIV services which may include sexually transmitted infection (STI) and viral hepatitis (VH) prevention and testing services to 37 North-Central Missouri communities. The contract is a renewal of a contract that combined two previous HIV Prevention and Ending the HIV Epidemic contracts which also served 37 counties while adding a new expanded testing program for the region.
