Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Maternal Child Health Services Contract Amendment 04

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Maternal Child Health Services Contract Amendment 04 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$73,124.36 for the period of October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025.

Discussion

Maternal Child Health (MCH) funding enables the department to provide community based maternal-child health planning, outreach and education to citizens of Boone County. Addressing adolescent mental health is the current focus for MCH activities. This year's funding (\$73,124.36) is a slight increase from last year (\$73,082).
