Re: Setting a public hearing: proposed replacement and improvement of public storm drainage infrastructure on West Sexton Road and McBaine Avenue

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution to set a public hearing on November 6, 2023 concerning the replacement and improvement of public storm drainage infrastructure on West Sexton Road and McBaine Avenue. The project location is shown on the attached Location Map. An interested parties meeting was held on March 22, 2023. The resolution estimate for this project is \$640,000 to be paid from Stormwater Utility funds.

## Discussion

The Sexton-McBaine Stormwater Improvement Project will consist of constructing approximately 650 feet of stormwater conveyance and seven (7) stormwater structures, as shown on the Project Graphic. The existing stormwater system is undersized and in poor condition, causing road flooding. The construction of the project will likely be completed in phases, allowing the project to move forward in a timely manner while minimizing neighborhood disruptions. The project is designed to accommodate the 10-year storm return interval.

An Interested Parties (IP) Meeting was held on March 22, 2023 at City Hall. One property owner attended the meeting and was in support of this project. The resolution estimate for the stormwater project is \$640,000 and will be paid from Stormwater Utility funds. This project was identified in the 2015 Storm Water ballot initiative.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The resolution estimate is \$640,000.

Long-Term Impact: Minimal impact to operations costs, reduction in potential to respond to infrastructure failures.
