# FOURTH AMENDMENT to the SOCIAL SERVICES PROVIDER AGREEMENT

This Fourth Amendment to the Social Services Provider Agreement ("Fourth Amendment") between the City of Columbia ("City") and Wilkes Boulevard United Methodist Church, Incorporated ("Provider"), is made as of the date of the last signatory noted below ("Amendment Effective Date").

#### **RECITALS**

- A. WHEREAS, on December 21, 2021, City and Provider entered into an Agreement ("Provider Agreement") for services related to the operation of a homeless drop-in center; and
- B. WHEREAS, on October 18, 2022, the Parties amended the Agreement to make overnight warming center services available to the unsheltered homeless population during periods of extreme cold weather ("First Amendment"); and
- C. WHEREAS, on December 20, 2022, the Parties amended the Agreement to make additional homeless drop-in center services available to the unsheltered homeless population on Sundays ("Second Amendment"); and
- D. WHEREAS, on December 4, 2023, the Parties amended the Agreement to make additional homeless drop-in center services available to the unsheltered homeless population ("Third Amendment"); and
- E. WHEREAS, the Parties seek to make additional overnight warming and cooling center services available to the unsheltered homeless population; and
- F. WHEREAS, the Parties hereto desire to formally amend the Provider Agreement as previously amended and desire to be bound by the terms contained in the Provider Agreement as previously amended by the First, Second, and Third Amendments and further amended by this Fourth Amendment.

#### **AMENDMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefit to be derived by the parties, it is agreed to amend the Provider Agreement as previously amended by the Third Amendment, as follows:

- 1. Section 1 g. of the Provider Agreement, as previously amended, is hereby removed and replaced with the following:
  - "g. The total allowable compensation for the Program Services during the Third Renewal Term (01/01/2025-12/31/2025) shall not exceed \$431,978.58."
- 2. Exhibit A4, attached hereto, it hereby incorporated by reference. The Program Services and Pricing set forth in Exhibit A4 is applicable during the Third Renewal Term only.
- 3. All other terms of the Provider Agreement, as previously amended, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
