Re: Renewal of Road Maintenance Agreement with Boone County, Missouri

Impacted Ward: Citywide

Executive Summary

Staff is requesting Council authorize the City Manager to execute Contract Amendment #2 of the Boone County and City of Columbia Road Maintenance Agreement to formalize ongoing maintenance responsibilities of roads along the geographic boundary of the Columbia city limits.

Discussion

Contract Amendment #2 to the Boone County and City of Columbia Road Maintenance Agreement is needed to update the Boone County and City of Columbia Road Maintenance Responsibility Map, to include new developments that have occurred in and around the Columbia City limits. There are no additional changes to the original agreement approved by Council March 16, 2020.

This agreement will automatically renew for additional one-year terms unless terminated by either agency. On an annual basis, both agencies will review county development activity and city annexation activity to determine if any changes to the base map are advisable. If changes to the map are needed, and are mutually agreed upon by both agencies, the agreement will be amended with an updated map reference, adjusting limits of maintenance with respect to changes in annexation and infrastructure development. City and County staff believe that this agreement represents a best effort to create a neutral cost scenario for both agencies with respect to the long-term costs of roadway maintenance.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: Costs will vary depending on the project; however, costs are anticipated to be the same as if the agreement were not in place.

Long-Term Impact: Costs are expected to be the same or less costs since both agencies will be able to more easily proactive maintenance on longer stretches of road.
