Re: Setting a public hearing: proposed construction of stormwater improvements on Quail Drive, Phase 2

Impacted Ward: Ward 3

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution to set a public hearing on March 2, 2026 concerning the replacement and improvement of public storm drainage infrastructure on Quail Drive. The project location is shown on the attached map. An interested parties meeting was held on November 12, 2025. The estimate for the stormwater project is \$130,000, to be paid from Stormwater Utility funds.

Discussion

This project was identified in discussions with property owners and residents during the initial phase of the Quail Drive Stormwater Improvements Project.

As shown on the attached Project Graphic, Phase 2 of the Quail Drive Stormwater Improvements Project will replace a failing corrugated metal stormwater pipe (CMP) and inlet at the east end of Quail Drive with a more effective system to reduce flooding and erosion issues. The existing CMP has rusted through and collapsed and the grated inlet and a flume at the end of the cul-de-sac clogged frequently leading to uncontrolled stormwater causing erosion and flooding problems.

The proposed stormwater improvements include replacing 70 feet of failed CMP, an inlet and a flume with 3 inlets, a junction box and 180 feet of new pipe.

Stormwater Utility staff hosted an Interested Parties Meeting at City Hall on November 12, 2025. One owner of property adjacent to the project was unable to attend, but called to support the project. One resident of Quail Drive attended the meeting to urge staff to pay attention to particular aspects of design and construction of the project. See attached contact log.

The estimate for the stormwater project is \$130,000, and financing for this project will be through the Stormwater Utility funds.

Fiscal Impact
