- Prepare technical reports on historic resources within the survey area, detailing findings and recommendations for further surveys.

Archival Research:

• Conduct research to gather historical context and background information essential for assessments and reports. Research shall meet requirements of Missouri SHPO.

Standard Analysis:

• Analyze potential impacts of proposed projects on historic resources in accordance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.

Historic Recordation:

- Complete the Missouri Architectural/Historic Inventory Forms, per SHPO "Instructions for Completing the Architectural/Historic Inventory Form" (including vacant lots).
- Generate a boundary map of survey area, documenting the location of each property inventoried.

Public Engagement and Presentations:

• Provide assistance and submit documentation for two public information meetings as requested.

Final Survey Report:

- Describing scope and scale of the survey along with methodology, area historical information of survey area.
- Define context of resources and eligibility criteria for NRHP listing.
