

475-74 Amend Chapter 15 relating to in-lieu-of-tax payments.

Bill was given second reading. Mayor Anderson moved and Councilman Hanson seconded the motion to amend the bill by changing the figures in Paragraphs A, B and C to read 1.075268. All voted "yes". Motion carried. Council and public comments were called for and none received. Bill was given third reading with effective date of March 1, 1975 and the vote taken, with Hanson, Pugh, Frueh, Wilson, Anderson, Barnes and Warren voting "Yes". Ordinance enacted, reading as follows:

AN ORDINANCE (6559)

amending Article V, Chapter 15, relating to Water and Electric Rates, of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Columbia, MO, 1964, by repealing Section 15.645 and in lieu thereof enacting a new Section 15.645; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Article V, Chapter 15, relating to Water and Electric Rates, of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, 1964, be, and the same is hereby amended by repealing Section 15.645 and in lieu thereof enacting a new Section 15.645, and the same is hereby enacted to read in words and figures as follows:

"Chapter 15: Water and Light Department

Section 15.645. Customer Bills and In Lieu of Tax Payemnt.

A seven percent (7%) in lieu of gross receipts tax payment shall be charged on cusomter bills for water, electricity and private street and outdoor area lighting. Said in lieu of tax payemnt shall be applied by the Water and Light Department to monthly bills for the above services, as follows:

A. For water, the amount of the customer's bill as determined by the applicable rate, excluding any other taxes, multiplied by 1.075268;

B. For electricity, the amount of the customer's bill as determined by the applicable rate including all adjustments but excluding any other taxes, multiplied by 1.075268; and

C. For private street and outdoor area lighting service the amount of the customer's bill excluding any other taxes, multiplied by 1.075268.

Sales tax, when applicable shall be applied to the entire amounts as computed above."

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after March 1, 1975.
