Re: Department of Corrections TB testing Amendment 001

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment 001 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Corrections for the period of July 1, 2024 through June 20, 2025 for the purposes of administering and reading tuberculosis skin tests (TST).

Discussion

The Department of Corrections (DOC) contracts with the Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to provide community-based tuberculosis skin testing to its employees, volunteers and interns. If tests are positive, PHHS provides education to the employee on the risks, consequences and treatment of tuberculosis infections. DOC reimburses PHHS \$20 per TST administration and reading. This is a one-year renewal of the existing agreement.
