Re: Burrell, Inc

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement between Burrell, Inc and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. This agreement with Burrell, Inc addresses one of the priority areas, mental health. Under this agreement, Burrell, Inc will construct a nonprofit crisis center on its property at 90 E Leslie and 107 E Texas. Once the construction of the crisis center is complete, Burrell, Inc will provide behavioral crisis services for Columbia residents. The agreement is for \$3,000,000.
