Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement between IN2ACTION and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. This agreement with IN2ACTION addresses one of the priority areas, community violence. This is the first of two agreements with IN2ACTION. The second agreement will come at a later date. Under this agreement, IN2ACTION will renovate for the Just One Respite House, a small group home for people with substance use disorder, located at 2501 Eastwood. The agreement is for \$550,000.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: This would issue \$550,000 for a project which is funded with City ARPA funds.
