Re: Authorizing the Temporary Restriction or Closure of Driving Lanes, Parking Lanes, and Sidewalk for two University of Missouri demolition projects.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the University of Missouri to temporarily restrict driving lanes and close parking lanes and sidewalk for the following demolition projects:

Loeb Hall – temporarily restrict driving lanes and close parking lanes and sidewalk along South Fifth Street between Elm Street and East Stewart Road from April 21, 2022 through August 10, 2022.

London Hall - temporarily restrict driving lanes and close parking lanes and sidewalk along East Stewart Road between South Fifth Street and South Sixth Street from April 21, 2022 through August 10, 2022.

Discussion

The driving lane, parking lane, and sidewalk restrictions/closures include:

- Restriction of both driving lanes and closure of both parking lanes and east sidewalk of South Fifth Street from April 21, 2022 through August 10, 2022.
- Restriction of both driving lanes and closure of both parking lanes and south sidewalk of East Stewart Road between South Fifth Street and South Sixth Street from April 21, 2022 through August 10, 2022.

The University of Missouri will be demolishing Loeb Hall and London Hall on the Campus of the University of Missouri. Staff has reviewed the attached traffic control plans and has no other issues with their request.

The University of Missouri owns all of the property adjacent to the closure.

The University of Missouri and/or its contractor will be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public. The University of Missouri is exempt from any public inconvenience fee.
