Re: Subscription agreement with Ares Private Markets Fund for the Police and Fire Pension

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager, or delegate, to sign a contract for investment services with Ares Private Markets Fund for the Police and Fire Pension Plan and to invest in securities offered by such Fund.

Discussion

At the September 12, 2025 Police & Fire Retirement Board meeting, members of the Police and Fire Investment Pension Board passed a motion to add Ares Private Markets Fund as an option in the alternatives allocation to help round out its diversified portfolio. This decision was reached after a meeting with the company, and consultation with the board's financial advisors regarding the investment opportunity.

Ares Private Markets Fund is a global alternative investor, offering complementary primary and secondary investment solutions across credit, real estate, private equity and infrastructure asset classes. The Fund's investment objective is to seek attractive long-term capital appreciation. In pursuing its investment objective, the Fund invests in an actively managed portfolio of private equity and other private assets.

This contract needs Council approval because the investment type is outside the scope of the current investment policy adopted by the Council, and thus requires a vote of the Council. This type of asset would fall under the "Alternatives" category in which the City has a minimum allocation of 0%, a target of 5%, and maximum allocation of 20% of the entire portfolio. This investment option would help the pension to achieve its alternatives target of 5%.
