A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Hulen Drive, south of Rollins Road; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, interested parties meetings for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Hulen Drive, south of Rollins Road, were held by the Public Works Department on May 8, 2023 and October 24, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri at 7:00 p.m. on January 16, 2024. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Hulen Drive, south of Rollins Road, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include the construction of three (3) speed tables and two (2) speed humps on Hulen Drive as follows:

- Speed table at Hulen Drive and Malibu Court.
- Speed table at Hulen Drive and Luan Court.
- Speed table at Hulen Drive and Ridgefield Road.
- Speed hump on Hulen Drive near 907 Hulen Drive.
- Speed hump on Hulen Drive near 1104 Hulen Drive.

SECTION 3. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$32,000.00.

SECTION 4. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from Annual Traffic Calming Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 5. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
