Dear Mr. Riley:

This letter serves as the official notice that your application for MoDOT Freight Enhancement Funds (FRE) for the COLT rail replacement has been chosen for funding. You will be reimbursed 53.7% of the cost up to \$328,260 for this project.

The first step in the FRE process is for City of Columbia/COLT to register in Missouri Buys to receive a Vendor ID number. I am attaching additional information to get you started on this process.

After you have completed the registration, please send my office:

- the Vendor ID number
- Email addresses for those who will be executing the Agreement between the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) and City of Columbia
- Resolution from City of Columbia authorizing the acceptance of funds, execution of the Agreement, and delegation of authority to submit invoices for the project
- A request for a DocuSign pin if your organization does not already have one

Once we receive this information, my office can finalize drafting of the Agreement.

As a general rule, call or email my office before committing to purchase any goods or services for this project. We will walk through each step to help ensure all the expenditures are eligible for reimbursement.
