Re: Destiny of H.O.P.E.

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign a second amendment to an agreement for services between Destiny of H.O.P.E. and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. On December 4, 2023 Council authorized the City Manager to sign an agreement with Destiny of H.O.P.E to address community violence. The agreement was for \$320,000 and ends on January 31, 2027. On February 5, 2024 an amendment to the agreement provided startup funds which were included in the \$320,000, and therefore, reduced the total number of services. The second amendment will increase the total agreement amount to \$453,333.33. The time period and other terms of the agreement will remain unchanged.
