Re: Authorizing construction of the Calvert Drive Stormwater Improvement Project; calling for

bids through the Purchasing Division.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for council consideration an ordinance authorizing construction and a bid call through the Purchasing Division for the Calvert Drive Stormwater Improvement Project, see attached Location Map. The public hearing for this project was held on October 16, 2023. The estimate for the Calvert Drive Stormwater Improvement project is \$3,400,000 and will be paid from Storm Water Utility funds. The estimate for the Calvert Drive Sewer Improvement project is \$255,000 and will be paid from Sewer Utility funds.

Discussion

Calvert Drive Stormwater and Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project will consist of constructing stormwater infrastructure improvements on Vandiver Drive and Sylvan Lane, a regional detention basin at Calvert Drive, and relocating the sanitary sewer at Calvert Drive.

The proposed stormwater improvements include 2,080 feet of new stormwater conveyance, ten (10) inlets and eight (8) stormwater structures as well as a detention basin and its appurtenances. The proposed sanitary sewer improvements include approximately 490 feet of new sewer pipe and three (3) new sanitary sewer structures. Refer to the Stormwater Project Graphic and Sewer Project Graphic. Upgrading the storm system is proposed to reduce the occurrence of street flooding and eliminate future storm system maintenance from under the building. The proposed stormwater system will drain into a new regional detention basin, providing water quality treatment and flood detention for approximately 35 acres of drainage area in the Hinkson Creek watershed. The sewer relocation work is required to construct the new detention basin.

The cost estimate for the stormwater project is \$3,400,000 to be paid from Storm Water Utility funds. The estimate for the sanitary sewer project is \$255,000 to be paid from Sewer Utility funds. The Calvert Drive stormwater project has been approved by Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) for \$2,219,928.20 in reimbursable American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. A partial award of \$42,154.00, with \$33,301.66 being grant, was agreed to with MDNR at the December 18, 2023 Council meeting. The remaining grant will be awarded after MDNR reviews the construction bids, the grant award will return to Council for approval in the future. Construction is expected to begin in fiscal year 2025.
