Re: Authorizing approval of a financial assistance agreement with the Mid-Missouri Solid

Waste Management District for grant funding to purchase a new mini-rolloff truck.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute a Financial Assistance agreement with the Mid Missouri Solid Waste Management District (MMSWMD) for the purchase of a new mini-rolloff truck.

Discussion

In February 2025 Solid Waste Division applied for grant funding from the Mid Missouri Solid Waste Management District. The purpose of the grant funding is to assist in the purchase of a new mini-rolloff truck dedicated to servicing mini-rolloff containers at apartment complexes. Solid Waste applied for and has received the maximum grant amount of \$100,000. The new mini-rolloff truck would replace an existing truck that is nine years old and has reached the end of its useful life. The replacement cost is estimated to be \$200,215; therefore, the City's matching amount is \$100,215.

Staff and the MMSWMD recognize that due to the April 20,2025 storm, the recycling program's needs have changed. After this agreement with the MMSWMD is executed, then the agreement can be amended to assist in other needs of the City of Columbia's recycling program. See the attached letter from the Mid Missouri Solid Waste Management District. Staff will return with an amendment to this agreement describing what the grant money will be used for once those details are worked out.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: A mini-rolloff truck costs approximately \$200,215. The MMSWMD grant is \$100,000 requiring the Solid Waste Utility to fund \$100,215 in order to purchase the truck. Long-Term Impact: None.
