Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Show Me Healthy Women Contract

## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Show Me Healthy Women Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services in an amount not to exceed \$4,000 for the period of June 30, 2022 through June 29, 2023.

## Discussion

This contract allows Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to provide community-based breast and cervical cancer screening for low income, uninsured women. The Show Me Healthy Women program provides breast and cervical cancer screening and treatment services to low income, uninsured or underinsured women. Low-income women become eligible for the Show Me Healthy Women program at age 35 for cervical cancer screening services and at age 50 for breast cancer screening services.
