## AMENDMENT

#### to the

# 2024 AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES RELATED AND REASONABLY PROPORTIONAL TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR NEGATIVE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF COVID 19

This First Amendment to the 2024 Agreement between the CITY OF COLUMBIA ("CITY"), and COMO Mobile Aid Collective, ("Provider") is made as of the date of the last signatory noted below.

#### **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2024, CITY and Provider entered into an Agreement ("2024 Agreement") for Homeless Street Outreach Program Services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties hereto desire to formally amend the 2024 Agreement with this First Amendment (hereinafter "First Amendment") and desire to be bound by the terms contained in the 2024 Agreement as amended or supplemented by those terms contained in this First Amendment.

#### <u>AMENDMENT</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefit to be derived by the parties, it is agreed to amend the 2024 Agreement, as follows:

- Exhibit B shall be amended to remove "Not applicable" and to include the Schedule set forth in the attached Exhibit B.
- 2. The following Outcome, Indicator, and Method of Measurement are hereby removed from Exhibit D:

Outcome: Homeless individuals will maintain or gain housing stability Indicator: 50% of individuals will make contact (verbal or in-person) with the next stage of securing housing, including vouchers, temporary housing, and emergency shelters.

<u>Method of Measurement</u>: Point-in-time counts at shelters and verbal provision by those served.

3. In Exhibit D, under the Outcome of "Immediate basic needs are met for homeless individuals", the following Indicator and Method of Measurement, are hereby removed from Exhibit D:

<u>Indicator</u>: 75% of individuals will be provided shelter from the elements for one night

<u>Method of Measurement</u>: Number of unique individuals at point-in-time counts at emergency shelters; number of unique individuals provided with a tent/tarp.

4. In Exhibit D, under the Outcome of "Immediate basic needs are met for homeless individuals", the Parties agree to add the word "consenting" to the outcome related to medical care so that the sentence reads: "75% of consenting individuals will receive medical care for concerns indicated."

All other terms of the 2024 Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
