Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Maternal Child Health Services Contract Amendment 02

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Maternal Child Health Services Contract Amendment 02 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$72,507.97 for the period of October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

Discussion

Maternal Child Health (MCH) funding enables the department to provide community based maternal-child health planning, outreach and education to citizens of Boone County. Addressing adolescent mental health is the focus of MCH activities for the coming fiscal year. Amendment 02 deletes Attachment C- Maternal Child Health Services Contract Work Plan of the original contract and replaces it with a revised Attachment C. This change has no fiscal impact on the grant.
