Re: Crestridge Drive Culvert Replacement Authorizing Acquisition of Easements

Impacted Ward: Ward 4

Executive Summary

This legislation authorizes staff to acquire easements for the Crestridge Drive Culvert Replacement Project.

Discussion

The Crestridge Drive Culvert Replacement Project will consist of replacing and improving the public storm drainage infrastructure on Crestridge Drive as shown on the attached Location Map. The existing culvert is undersized and in poor condition. The lack of capacity in the existing culvert causes severe flooding and debris deposition in yards and streets.

This project will require the acquisition of four (4) Temporary Construction Easements and three (3) Permanent Drainage Easements. The Project Graphics show the extent of the work to be performed and the extent of the easements to be acquired.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: \$935,000

Long-Term Impact: The project will reduce the cost to remove flood debris from College Park Drive, a maintenance cost that is difficult to quantify.
