Re: Authorizing construction of the Alan Lane Stormwater Improvement Project; calling for bids through the Purchasing Division or authorizing a contract for the work using a term and supply contractor.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for council consideration an ordinance authorizing construction and issuing a contract for the work or a bid call through the Purchasing Division for the Alan Lane Stormwater Improvement Project, as shown on the attached Project Graphic. The public hearing for this project was held on February 20, 2023. The estimate for this project is \$675,000 and will be paid from Storm Water Utility funds.

Discussion

The Alan Lane Stormwater Improvement Project will include replacement and improvement of public storm drainage infrastructure on Alan Lane, McKee Street, Boyd Lane and Oriole Lane. The project will consist of constructing approximately 700 feet of new stormwater pipe and ten (10) stormwater structures. The proposed improvements will eliminate the need for a failing private storm pipe, improve stormwater management and reduce the occurrence of structures flooding. The proposed pipe alignment in Boyd Lane will be within the street pavement per Council direction at the public hearing.

Staff anticipates utilizing an existing term and supply contract for this project. However, this ordinance authorizes construction either through the City's term and supply contracts or by bidding through Purchasing, whichever is most appropriate. Construction is expected in fiscal year 2025.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The estimate is \$675,000 to be paid from the Storm Water Utility funds.

Long-Term Impact: Minimal impact on the Storm Water Utility's annual operating cost.
