Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of Section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified family-friendly music for a private wedding event on Sunday, October 2, 2022.

Discussion

Bryan Maness, of Ozark Roots LLC, dba Ozark Mountain Biscuit & Bar has requested waiver of ordinance Sec. 16-258 to have amplified music for a neighborhood concert on private property on the patio of the restaurant located at 1204 Hinkson Avenue. This event will take place on Sunday, October 2, 2022 from 5:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.

Per ordinance, a waiver is required when amplified sound can be heard more than 100 feet away from the source outside of the downtown foot print. Estimated attendance for this event is 125 participants.

This event has met qualifications to bring to City Council for approval.
