Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Enhancing Detection (ED) Expansion Amendment 05 contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the period of July 1, 2021 through July 31, 2025 in an amount not to exceed \$1,452,371.

Discussion

The Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Enhancing Detection (ED) Expansion grant, which was executed in December 2021, allowed for provision of activities related to the COVID-19 response. Activities include case investigation, contact tracing, surveillance, testing, health education, and professional development. Amendment 05 allows for revisions within the contract, including deletion of contact tracing and the addition of prior approval for all expenditures. There are no changes to the contract term or funding amount. Public Health and Human Services will use the remaining funds for staff to provide health education and to conduct epidemiological surveillance and reporting. Funding will also be provided to purchase COVID/Flu testing kits. These funds were included in the FY25 budget.
