Re: Resolution granting a temporary waiver from the requirements of section 16-186 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified music for Ninth Street Summerfests.

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of Section 16-186 and 16-258 to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and amplified music for two Summerfest events.

## Discussion

FPC Live, doing business as The Blue Note, has requested closure of Ninth Street from Broadway to Walnut to hold 9<sup>th</sup> Street Summerfests on Friday, May 20, 2022 and July 15, 2022. This request includes a temporary waiver of section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified music during the dates and times below:

- Country music act on Friday, May 20, 2022. The closure is requested from 7:00 a.m. on Friday, May 20, 2022 until 1:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 21, 2022.
- Country music act on Friday, July 15, 2022. The closure is requested from 7:00 a.m. on Friday, July 15, 2022 until 1:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 16, 2022.

The Renfro Refreshment Company has requested a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages on Ninth Street for events on Friday, May 20, 2022 from 6:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. with the estimated attendance to be 3,000 and Friday, July 15, 2022 from 6:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. with the estimated attendance to be 3,000.

The City Event Committee has approved the application for these events pending Council approval. Conditions of approval have included use of barricades that are compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) to block the street and alleyways and procurement of required liquor licensing and liquor liability insurance.

Per City Ordinance 24-73b, an operations agreement is only required for a downtown street closure if the event is to take place the day before, or the day of, any scheduled University of Missouri home football game. The aforementioned requested events are not on University of Missouri home football game weekends.
