Re: Contract Authorization – FY 2027 Consolidated Planning Grant (CPG) (Case # 235-2026)

Executive Summary

Approval of the attached ordinance would authorize the City Manager to execute, as the contractor for the Columbia Area Transportation Study Organization (CATSO), the contract agreement associated with the FY 2027 Consolidated Planning Grant (CPG) funds with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) that are derived from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

Discussion

The attached ordinance seeks Council authorization to permit the City Manager to execute the FY 2027 Consolidated Planning Grant (CPG) contracts with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC). The approval of the attached ordinance and granting the City Manager authorization to execute the agreement are necessary to facilitate the annual contract renewal process of an ongoing grant program. If the authorization is granted, the City would be provided a total of \$1,000,265 in federal CPG funding for FY 2027 transportation planning purposes.

For reference purposes, the MoDOT grant number associated with this project is MP32601C. The Federal FMIS number is 00FY326 and CFDA number for the consolidated planning funds is 20.505, the same as the Federal Highway Administration PL number.

A copy of the CPG agreement is attached for review. Appendix A (page 16) of the agreement provides funding details per individual work activities.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: Approval of the ordinance and granting the City Manager authorization to execute the contract provides the opportunity to off-set 80% of eligible project costs, as shown in Appendix A of the Grant Agreement, when such costs are associated with transportation-related planning activities.
