Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the HIV Prevention Contract Renewal for the period of January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023. The contract amount shall not exceed \$114,911.

Discussion

HIV Prevention program funding enables the Department of Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to provide comprehensive Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) prevention services, which may also include sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and Viral Hepatitis (VH) within the 33 county Central Missouri Region. PHHS has provided these services for more than twenty years.
