Re: Subaward agreement for First Responders-Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act for Missouri

Executive Summary

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to sign the subaward agreement between the City of Columbia, MO and the Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of the University of Missouri-St. Louis for the period of September 30, 2021 through September 29, 2022 in an amount not to exceed \$14,112; appropriating funds.

Discussion

PHHS will partner with University of Missouri St. Louis - Missouri Institute for Mental health to prevent drug overdoses. PHHS will assist with coordinating planning sessions, will identify geographic hotspots of overdose activity, and will delegate a training liaison to participate in the SHIELD training in Boone County. PHHS will support the development of collaborative relationships between UMSL-MIMH and local first responder entities. PHHS will assist with collecting and compiling de-identified overdose data from local law enforcement agencies, ambulance districts, and the medical examiner's office to share with the UMSL-MIMH evaluation team as needed.
