Re: Amendment #03 to the Agreement with Patagonia Health, Inc.

Impacted Ward: Citywide

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign amendment #03 to the agreement with Patagonia Health, Inc. for the addition of a bi-directional lab interface with Quest Diagnostics, in the amount of \$2,000 with a \$30 per month subscription fee.

Discussion

Public Health and Human Services has used Patagonia as its electronic medical record (EMR) system since 2019 and has been able to receive laboratory results from Quest directly into the EMR since that time. The addition of a bi-directional interface will allow providers to also order Quest labs from within the EMR system rather than handwriting orders on a paper requisition. This addition will allow for increased provider efficiency in the clinic. The addition has a one-time fee of \$2,000 and a monthly subscription fee of \$30.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: There is a one-time expense of \$2,000 with a monthly fee of \$30 that will be absorbed by the current budget. No appropriation is needed.

Long-Term Impact: There will be an ongoing monthly subscription fee of \$30.
