Re: Agreement with Kansas City CARE Clinic for Project SPEED (Streamlined Protocol for Early Engagement and Delivery of HIV Prevention with Long-acting injectable Cabotegravir)

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign a Participation Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Kansas City CARE Clinic for Project SPEED ((Streamlined Protocol for Early Engagement and Delivery of HIV Prevention with Long-acting injectable Cabotegravir).

Discussion

This agreement is for participation in Project SPEED, a Phase IV, investigator-sponsored implementation science study evaluating a nurse-driven HIV Pre Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) delivery model in Missouri Local Public Health Departments. This is a two-year agreement which provides \$8,820 for control sites and \$15,220 intervention sites. PHHS will be randomly assigned to either the control group or intervention group after contract execution. If PHHS is selected for the intervention group, staff will participate in training and education related to PrEP delivery and protocols. Under the intervention arm, registered nurses would enroll participates and dispense PrEP. Both intervention and control group share deidentified data with Kansas City CARE Clinic.
