Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services WIC Local Agency Nutrition Services Program Services Contract

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the program services contract for WIC Local Agency Nutrition Services between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract period is October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

Discussion

This contract allows the Department of Public Health and Human Services to provide supplementary nutrition packages and nutrition education to low income pregnant and breastfeeding women, infants, and children through age 5 years.

Base funding is based on caseload number, which is determined by the average number of participants served in the previous year. The base grant for FY2023 is \$541, 913. Additional funding for special projects will be awarded for \$31, 994.00 for FY2023. The total funding for FY2023 is \$573, 907. The total funding has been reduced in FY2023 due to a decline in caseload over the previous two years.
