SUBJECT: 2025 MoDOT Statewide Safety Targets

DATE: December 4, 2025

The attached table shows MoDOT's annual statewide safety targets, which were provided to CATSO staff and other MPOs in August, 2025. These are included in the FHWA Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), which is a core Federal-aid program whose purpose is to achieve a reduction in traffic fatalities and major injuries on public roadways. CATSO, like other MPOs, has the option of either providing formal approval in support of the statewide targets, or to establish specific targets for the CATSO metropolitan planning area.

MPO decisions on adoption of statewide safety targets are due to the MoDOT Central Office by February 27, 2026.

CATSO staff finds the statewide targets acceptable and recommends that they be formally supported by Committee members.

Previous Technical Committee Action

At their November 5, 2025 meeting, the CATSO Technical Committee reviewed the proposed Statewide Safety Targets for potential adoption by CATSO. After review, the Committee passed a motion recommending that the Coordinating Committee adopt the Statewide Safety Targets at the December 4 meeting.
