## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Agreement for Purchase of Services between the City of Columbia and the Boone County Children's Services Board in an amount not to exceed \$24,999.60 for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.

Discussion

The Boone County Children's Services Grant provides funding to expand TOP (Teen Outreach Program) into the County. TOP is an after-school program designed to engage teens in guided discussions and community service. TOP has three main components; community service learning, peer experiences, and an adult resource network. These components are proven to impact youth and produce positive outcomes including decreased course-failure rate, school dropout rate, and teen pregnancy rate.
