Re: Voluntary Action Center – Opportunity Campus

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement between Voluntary Action Center and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. This agreement with Voluntary Action Center - Opportunity Campus addresses one of the priority areas, homelessness. Under this agreement, Voluntary Action Center will construct a nonprofit social service agency at 1300 Bowling Street to provide supportive services to unhoused and low income persons. The agreement is for \$3,000,000.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: This would issue \$3,000,000 for a project which is funded with City ARPA funds.
