Re: WIC Local Agency Agreement to promote the Missouri WIC Farmers' Market Nutrition

Program

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the WIC Local Agency Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Agriculture. This agreement is in effect until December 31, 2024 with two (2) automatic one-year renewals.

Discussion

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a mutually agreed upon framework under which Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) will provide assistance to the Missouri Department of Agriculture (MDA) to promote the Missouri WIC Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (MOFMNP) in our community and assist MDA in administering MOFMNP grant funding. This program provides \$20 per eligible participant for the purchase of eligible foods sold by an Authorized Farmer at a Farmers' Market and/or Roadside Stand. PHHS will enroll eligible recipients in MOFMNP and issue the program's benefits. Benefits are issued from May 1 through September 30 in the years in which the Agreement is in effect.
