AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

(RESERVE FUNDING)

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R104-21 that authorized the City of Columbia, Missouri (hereinafter "City") to enter into an agreement with The CHA Low-Income Services (CHALIS), an organization of the Housing Authority of the City of Columbia (a/k/a CHA)(hereinafter "Agency") for the purpose of providing a Housing Ambassador program to assist Housing Choice Voucher recipients seeking housing in low-poverty neighborhoods (hereinafter "the Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the agreement for a Housing Ambassador expired on December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration received City and Agenda agree as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 2a of the agreement is amended to read as follows:
 - a. Agency agrees that all work shall be completed and funds expended by December 31, 2023.
- 2. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Amendment, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
