Re: Authorizing the Temporary Closure of Driving Lanes and Sidewalks by the University of Missouri to Remove and Replace Steam Infrastructure under Rollins Street.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the University of Missouri to temporarily close driving lanes and sidewalks for the Rollins Street Steam Chase replacement construction project under Rollins Street between Hitt Street and South College Avenue from May 15, 2023 through September 29, 2023.

Discussion

The driving lane and sidewalk closures include the closure of both driving lanes and portions of both sidewalks of Rollins Street between Hitt Street and South College Avenue from May 15, 2023 through September 29, 2023.

The University of Missouri will be replacing the steam and condensate lines and chase in Rollins Street. This will require the removal and replacement of the Rollins Street pavement.

The University of Missouri owns all of the property adjacent to the closure.

The University of Missouri is requesting a right of way permit from MoDOT for the closure of the turn lane on College Avenue (MO Highway 763).

The University of Missouri and/or its contractor will be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public. The University of Missouri is exempt from any public inconvenience fee.
