Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Contract: Ending the HIV Epidemic

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment 02 to the Ending the HIV Epidemic Contract for the period of August 1, 2022 through July 31, 2023. The contract amount shall not exceed \$125,293.

Discussion

Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) entered into an initial agreement with Missouri Health and Senior Services in November, 2020 for the provision of comprehensive HIV services (which may include Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) and Viral Hepatitis (VH) prevention and testing services) to 33 north-central Missouri Communities. Grant funding provided through this project supports the development and implementation of programs tailored to ending the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) epidemic in Missouri and is used to fund a Health Educator position.
