

MONTHLY ELECTRIC STATEMENT – JANUARY 2024

Overview of the Monthly Financial Reports:

REVENUES:

1. Overall revenues for the month of January 2024 are up due to electric rate increases that took effect July 1, 2023.

EXPENSES:

1. Salaries and Wages – are higher due to wage increases that the City Manager proposed mid-year 2023 and with the FY 2024 budget
2. Materials, Supplies & Power Purchase – higher due to additional transmission expenses that are being paid to Sikeston and a large weekly payment (~\$2.8 million) that was made to MISO for the week of the cold snap.

January 2024 represents 33.33% of the budget year

- Electric operating revenues are currently at 31.40% of budget
 - Same time last year at 32.11% of the budget
- Electric operating expenses are currently at 27.84% of budget
 - Same time last year at 23.15% of the budget

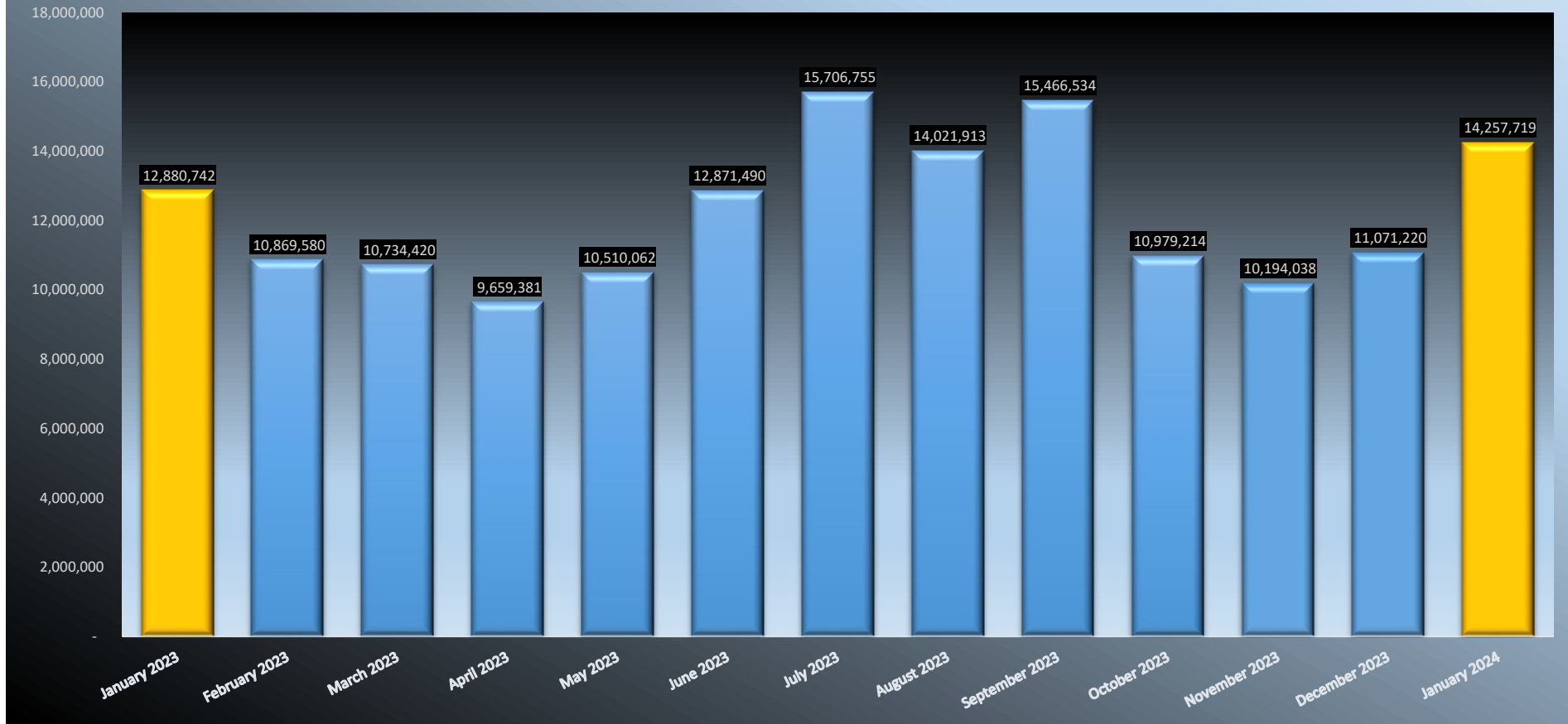
