## AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

## (RESERVE FUNDING)

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R107-21 that authorized the City of Columbia, Missouri (hereinafter "City") to enter into an agreement with Job Point (hereinafter "Agency") for the purpose of providing vocational training services to low- and moderate-income persons and households adversely affected by the coronavirus pandemic (hereinafter "the Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the agreement for vocational training services expired on December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration received City and Agenda agree as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 2a of the agreement is amended to read as follows:
  - a. Agency agrees that all work shall be completed and funds expended by December 31, 2023, when this agreement shall terminate.
- 2. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Amendment, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
