Re: Authorizing a Payment Processing Contract with PayIt LLC for Credit Card Processing

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign a contract for a payment processor with Paylt LLC.

Discussion

The City of Columbia Finance department is looking to improve its payment processing through the implementation of the Paylt Enterprise Platform. Paylt is a software as a service provider of digital government services and payments. Paylt simplifies doing business with government agencies by consolidating hundreds of services and payments into one connected experience for citizens. The implementation will start with replacing the payment processor for utility billing. Once that is completed and assessed, finance plans on looking at implementing Payit into all or most of its current online payment processors. Implementation of Paylt is expected to lead to an annual cost savings of \$18,000 as well as improved customer service and faster tech support.
