## FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI AND JOB POINT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the Agreement between the City of Columbia, Missouri and Job Point dated March 23, 2022 (hereinafter the "First Amendment") is made and entered into on the date of the last signatory noted below (hereinafter "Effective Date").

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia (hereinafter "City") and Job Point (hereinafter "Agency") entered into an Agreement on March 23, 2022 relating to the provision of vocational skills training for low to moderate income residents (hereinafter the "Original Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Original Agreement to modify the Scope of Work and Payments contained in Paragraph 1 and Exhibit A thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and Agency agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 1 of the Original Agreement is modified by amending the third sentence of such paragraph as follows:

Such costs shall include the purchase of software and a training simulator and the <del>purchase and</del> renovation of real-estate-provision of Columbia Builds Youth services as set forth in Exhibit A.

2. Exhibit A attached to the Original Agreement shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with Exhibit A attached hereto.

3. All other provisions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
