Subject: CEC Support of Livable Streets Policy and Inclusive Community Engagement Plan

The Climate and Environment Commission supports the Livable Streets Policy and Inclusive Community Engagement Plan prepared by Local Motion.

The commission received advance drafts of the policy and plan and the issue was placed on the agenda of the CEC's October 25, 2022 meeting. The policy and plan have direct connections to Columbia's Climate Action and Adaptation Plan. The policy prioritizes walkers, bikers, and transit riders, while accommodating vehicles, and the community engagement plan provides for a robust public process. At the October meeting, commissioners asked questions and Commissioner Triplett invited further CEC review and welcomed commissioners' comments.
