SUBJECT: Potential additional project for Draft Sidewalk Master Plan

DATE: September 21, 2022

The Planning and Zoning Commission recently reviewed the Sidewalk Master Plan (SMP) at their August 4 and August 18 work sessions.

A Planning & Zoning commission member proposed an additional project for the SMP. The suggested project is: Worley Street, north side, West Blvd to Banks Avenue. The project is included in the attached revised draft SMP project listing for the Commission's review, highlighted in larger bold print. The project matrix scores the suggested project as a Priority 2. Currently there is a sidewalk along the north side of Worley Street between Clinkscales and West Blvd, but no sidewalk exists on the north side between West and Banks.

The suggested segment is approximately 2,320 feet in length, and a very tentative cost estimate (using the average cost per lineal foot of the other major collector projects included in the SMP) is over \$1 million. The usual impacts would apply to implementation of the project, including the potential need to remove mature trees and other existing landscaping, acquisition of additional right-of-way, etc.

Suggested Bicycle & Pedestrian Commission Action

Have a discussion about the suggested project addition and give consideration to its addition. A date will be scheduled for a public hearing at the Planning & Zoning Commission once the BPC reviews this potential project.
