A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of both vehicular lanes and a portion of sidewalk on Tiger Avenue between Kentucky Boulevard and Rollins Street to facilitate the replacement of the field turf on Stankowski Field.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the University of Missouri the following temporary vehicular lane and sidewalk closures, as shown on "Exhibit A" attached hereto, from June 23, 2022 through July 31, 2022 to facilitate the replacement of the field turf on Stankowski Field:

- 1. Both vehicular lanes on Tiger Avenue between Kentucky Boulevard and Rollins Street.
- 2. The sidewalk on the east side of Tiger Avenue between Kentucky Boulevard and Rollins Street.

SECTION 2. The University of Missouri shall close the vehicular lanes and sidewalk only in accordance with the traffic control plans submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying The University of Missouri, in writing, of such requirements. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the vehicular lanes and sidewalk due to any damage caused by the activity. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. The University of Missouri shall proceed with activities which require the temporary vehicular lanes and sidewalk closures without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the closure permit by the City Council.

SECTION 4. The temporary closures authorized herein may be terminated by the City Council upon recommendation of the Director of Public Works and a determination such closures are no longer necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public or is otherwise in the best interest of the public.
